• **NADL Disaster Relief Fund:** The NADL Disaster Relief Fund is available to assist dental laboratories impacted by natural disasters.

Federal Resources

 Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA): Provides disaster relief funds, housing assistance, and recovery resources for businesses and individuals. Register for aid through FEMA's Individual Assistance program after a natural disaster.

• Small Business Administration (SBA) Disaster Assistance: Offers low-interest disaster loans to businesses, homeowners, and renters to repair or replace damaged property and cover economic injury caused by disasters.
